**Port Sunlight's founder William Lever believed that art and architecture had the power to improve and enrich people's lives.**



Come and enjoy all Port Sunlight has to offer, from the idyllic worker's cottages to the fine public buildings and elegant monuments. Your group will begin with a visit to Port Sunlight Museum and discover the founding and development of the village, along with stories past and present of those who lived and worked here. Next stop is the Edwardian worker's cottage, a chance to step back to 1913 and discover what a Port Sunlight home looked like over a century ago. Each room is filled with period artefacts and fascinating interpretation.

An experienced guide will then lead a coach tour around Port Sunlight Village, highlighting the different periods of architectural history represented in the village, alongside the unique designs and craftsmanship on display.

Your group will relax and enjoy a freshly made lunch in the Tea Room, with views overlooking the museum green. Once refuelled your group will make a visit to the Lady Lever Art Gallery, a beautiful building dedicated to the memory of William Lever's wife, Elizabeth. It houses one of the UK's finest collections of fine and decorative art, including internationally renowned collections of Pre-Raphaelite paintings and Wedgwood pottery.

The trip will conclude with a special curator-led tour of the nearby Williamson Art Gallery. Your group will discover a stunning collection of art representing regional and national artists, as well as The Della Robbia Collection – ceramics from a significant pottery established in Birkenhead in 1894.
