Originally built by William Lever to house the workers of his nearby soap factory, Lever Brothers. William Lever had a strong sense of social responsibility and created a village with architecturally interesting buildings, open green spaces and tree framed vistas to make Port Sunlight an uplifting place to live and work.

Today Port Sunlight Village is home to over 2,000 residents, an award-winning museum, the Edwardian worker's cottage experience and Bridge Cottage Community Hub.

The village is an ideal place for groups to explore. We offer extensive free coach parking, easy drop-off and pick-up points, disabled access throughout the site and a personalised meet and greet service.

Groups arriving by coach can experience an on-board guided coach tour, a wonderful way to explore the village and enjoy the Port Sunlight story - discovering the memorials, monuments, village houses and much more.

For those who wish to explore Port Sunlight by foot, we offer village walking tours led by experienced guides. Groups can discover Port Sunlight close up, uncovering the detail of the architecture and village life past and present.
